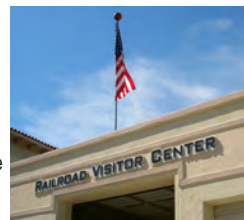

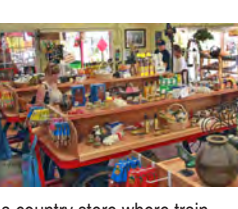

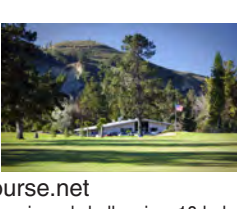
Main Street and the surrounding streets were established in the early 1900s with murals, eateries, shops, museums, historic inns abound under the historic clocktower.

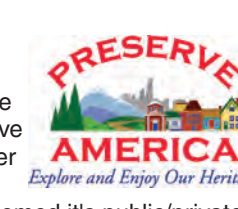

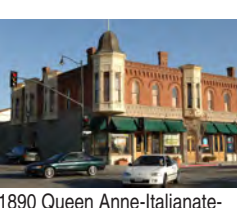

15 Preserve America Community



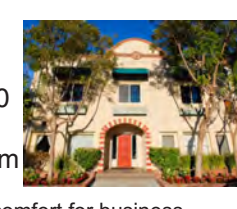
